



NATURIST VILLAGE CAP D'AGDE

CODE OF CONDUCT

AIMED TO ENSURE & RESPECT THE NATURIST QUALITY OF LIFE

The following recommendations concern all naturists : property owners, tenants, visitors and all other people working in the village : business owners, seasonal workers.

Naturism is a way to live in harmony with nature, characterised by nudity in public aiming to promote self-respect, respect of others and that of the environment.

French law is the same here as anywhere else in France, the only difference being is that nudity is accepted.

• **RESPECT OF NUDITY**

In the village, family naturism, source of well-being must be the norm.

Entire nudity must be the norm when the climate is suitable, while remaining sympathetic towards people who may have certain apprehensions discovering naturism for the first time and especially towards young people.

No voyeuristic or exhibitionist attitude will be accepted.

On the beach, nudity is obligatory.

• **RESPECT OF HYGIENE AND CLEANLINESS**

Personal hygiene is a must. By being clean, nudity is accepted in the shops, restaurants and cafés. Use of a towel to sit down is obligatory.

For hygiene reasons, shop owners are requested to protect all foods on display, especially foods unprotected by packaging.

• **RESPECT OF A WAY OF LIFE**

Public or private gardens must be respected by everyone.

Illegal advertising : posters, stickers, leaflets left on car windscreens or strewn in public or private places is not allowed (access to the village is prohibited to all who want to distribute publicity : Municipal by-laws n° 94-163, July 94 and n° 94-286 of December 30, 1994).

Dogs and other pets must always be kept on a leash. Their presence on the beach is strictly forbidden. Owners of dogs and cats must clean up their defecation (Municipal by-laws : n° 97-666 of August 28, 1997 and n° 484 of June 8, 2004).

General maintenance of the beach is the responsibility of the town's technical departments. However, each naturist must respect the general cleanliness of the area.

• **ACCESS**

Owners, tenants, and visitors must have some form of identity, comply to the rules and be prepared for possible controls.

Deliverers and temporary workers must be able to justify their business and give details of their working hours.

Long-term workers, syndicates and village employees should possess an entrance card provided only after proof is given by the employer.

During break times, all workers are free to use the public facilities of both the beach and the village but only by strictly respecting the rules of these areas.

Potential property buyers must be accompanied by people responsible for the selling.

Private guests are under the responsibility of the residents or business owners who must guarantee that they will respect the rules. Visitors must use the public parking areas situated at the entrance to the village.

• **RESPECT OF OTHERS**

Radios or other musical instruments and noisy entertainment are prohibited on the beach (Municipal by-law n° 98-126 of May 11, 1998).

Photography is only tolerated for family purposes.

Any advertising with sexual connotations on buildings or businesses is strictly prohibited.

Noise and disturbance of the peace at night are prohibited. Peace and quiet of the residents and holiday makers should be respected. The rules on noise in the naturist village are in accordance with local legislation.

Brief reminder of the Municipal by-law of December 12, 1994, the following are prohibited :

- any organised or spontaneous spectacle of a pornographic nature,
- any act of exhibition or enticement of a sexual nature,
- any form of advertising promoting shows of a pornographic nature,
- any form of exhibitionist clothing.

Speed limit for vehicles is limited to 30 km/h.

Avoid leaving engines on.

Both day and night visitors are asked to use the public parking areas.
